Repeat Prescriptions

You can order a repeat prescription in the following ways:

1. Tick the items required on the white portion of your prescription then place it into the red prescription box located on the wall in the reception area.
2. Order online using our secure system (ask at reception should you wish to register for the online facility).
3. Log into your NHS App to reorder your repeat medication.
4. For those patients who have an arrangement with the practice to request prescriptions by telephone, please continue to do so.

Please remember to allow 48 hours for prescription requests.
